**Purpose of the international seminar**

The seminar is organized on the 25th anniversary of the introduction of the reform of local self-government administration, the second stage of the creation of local government levels: voivodeship and district. The meeting is also organized on the occasion of the 25th anniversary of studies in administration at UJD Częstochowa, currently at the Faculty of Law and Economics.

After 25 years of functioning of the three-tier local self-government in Poland, a number of questions undoubtedly arise, in particular whether there are any necessary changes in the political system in the functioning of local government for the next 25 years? Should the administrative division of the state be corrected, or should the scope of tasks and competences of local government units be rebuilt, including the sources of financing of local government units?

The aim of the seminar is a multi-aspect and interdisciplinary debate on the indicated issues at the level of science, as well as practice with the participation of both legal theoreticians and representatives of those who create law, with the participation of a wide range
